## **Quail Ridge II Parking Policy**

The Quail Ridge II Neighborhood Association Board implements this parking policy on October 12, 2013. This policy supersedes and replaces the Parking Policy implemented on November 11, 2005. Parking on the streets and alleys in the Quail Ridge II Neighborhood is prohibited because such parking

- a) detracts from the architectural harmony of the neighborhood, and
- b) causes reduced street and alley access to normal traffic flow and emergency vehicles.

Vehicles shall not be parked on the streets or in the alleys.

As a courtesy to our neighbors, when short-term street parking is unavoidable due to construction work, deliveries, social events, meetings, etc., resident should inform the ACC chair or the board president so that they can inform the community of the temporary parking situation.

Complaints about parking violations should be sent by email or in writing to the ACC chairman. The ACC chairman will investigate the complaint and attempt to resolve the issue. If there is not resolution, the neighbors will be asked to meet with the HOA Board.
